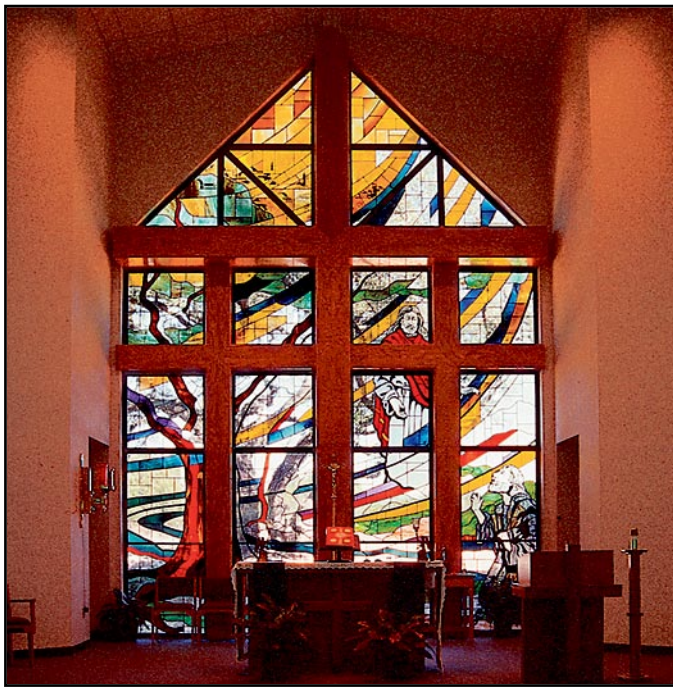

these times.

Several parishioners have expressed concern about the  
upstairs area used during Mass for families with small  
children. They say that there are often many people up there  
without children who appear to be using the space to avoid  
sitting in the main assembly area. They also say that there  
seems to be little effort by some parents to control or set limits  
for their children when they are upstairs. This makes it very  
difficult for others to attend Mass in a prayerful way.

Because the upstairs area is still part of the church, and  
because those who are there during Mass have the right to a  
positive prayer experience, we will institute the following  
procedures beginning Saturday, March 1.

1) Ushers will be at the foot of the stairs before Mass. They  
will only allow families with small children to go upstairs. Once  
15 families have gone upstairs, the area will be closed to  
others. Anyone arriving after that time will have to sit in the  
main assembly area.

2) Parents are reminded that they have the responsibility to  
teach their children proper behavior during Mass. If children  
are "out of control" upstairs, ushers will ask the parents to  
remedy the situation. This way all children upstairs will have  
the opportunity to learn proper behavior and adults will have a  
better opportunity to attend Mass prayerfully.

Please know that our intent is to try and help parents who  
wish to teach their children proper behavior during Mass.  
Thank you for your cooperation.
