The application for Ministry is identical for volunteers, paid staff and clergy and should ideally be submitted prior to workshop attendance. Submitting an application permits the diocese to run a confidential background check on each applicant. If internet access is not available, your parish/school can provide a paper copy of the application which you return to your parish/school to be confidentially entered into the database. The on-line application process is secure and confidential.
