John Paul, II, Encyclical Letter: The Gospel of Life

The U. S. Department of Health & Human Services is inviting public comment on a proposal to rescind an important December, 2008 federal regulation that protects the conscience rights of health care providers. Freedom of Choice Act (FOCA) - The Diocese of Austin will be participating in a national email campaign to make known our opposition to the Freedom of Choice Act. FOCA goes far beyond the Roe v. Wade decision to make abortion an entitlement that the government must fund and promote. This bill would override state regulation of abortion, remove a parent's right to be involved in their minor daughter's abortion decision & require states to allow partial-birth abortion and other late-term abortions.
