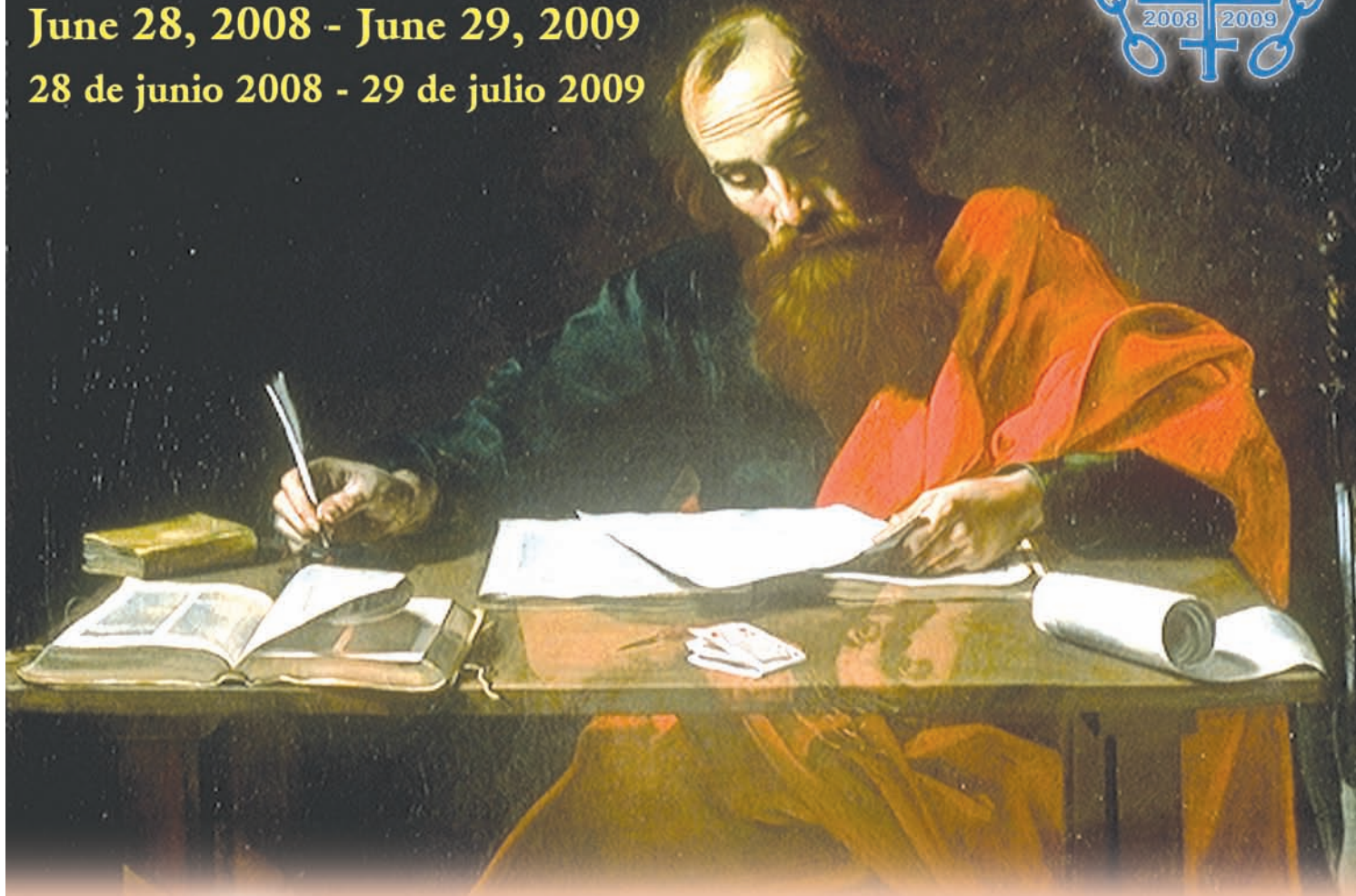

Basilica of Saint Paul Outside the Walls, Rome, Italy

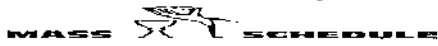

Couples planning to marry should contact their priest or deacon at least six months prior to their wedding date in order to begin the marriage preparation process. Engaged couples are encouraged to inquire at their parish about pre-marriage retreats and classes.

Couples must also provide proof they have taken either the FOCUS or PREPARE assessment before attending the "Together in God's Image" classes or retreat.
